

Update for Participants



The Northern Sydney Regional Organisation of Councils food scraps recycling research project has now finished. Thank you again to those people who participated.

Waste collection services ended in the week commencing **20 June** for the eight residential areas in Lane Cove, Willoughby and Ryde council areas. Bins were progressively removed or changed back to red-lid bins after the last pick-up.

All participants were invited to respond to a survey about their experience of the trial and over 500 did so. Over half the responses were from people living in houses, even though houses made up less than a third of the total number of households.

The Final Report has now been completed and a shorter Summary Report is also available on the project web page.

Now that the trial is over, food scraps in the red-lid bin will continue to go through a process that turns organic waste into low-grade compost for rehabilitating a mine site.
