Introduction

NSROC is seeking applications from experts in the fields of architecture, urban design, landscape design and sustainability to become members of the panel list to serve on the Design Review Panels and Design Excellence Panels in the council areas of Hunters Hill, Lane Cove, Mosman and Willoughby.

The Panels will evaluate and critique design aspects of proposed developments and provide recommendations on how the development can better achieve design excellence and best practice sustainability.

Panel members shall be engaged as a contractor and remuneration for Panel members (excluding GST) will be as follows-

Selection Criteria

Expressions of Interest to become a Panel member must be made online and include a brief professional profile addressing the selection criteria below:

- Demonstrated extensive experience within one or more of the following disciplines; Architecture, Landscape architecture, Urban design or sustainability.
- Suitably qualified to be eligible for membership with the relevant professional body.
- Ability to understand and interpret local environmental plans, policies and development controls.
- Demonstrated experience and skills to provide expert Panel advice, and willingness to liaise and prepare joint reports with other members of the Panel in a timely manner.
- Demonstrated ability to critically consider design elements to achieve favourable planning outcomes consistent with planning instruments and development controls.
- Good written and verbal communication skills to contribute in group discussions including the ability to translate technical information into plain English.
- Public Liability Insurance (\$20 million), Professional Indemnity Insurance (\$5 million) and certificate of currency for Workers Compensation Insurance.
